## **Bachelor of Trauma and Healing**

## Detail:

The Bachelor of Trauma and Healing degree is an undergraduate qualification consisting of 24 units and normally takes three years full-time study or the part-time equivalent. The course is identified at Level 7 of the Australian Qualifications Framework. This course responds to the documented demand within both Indigenous and non-Indigenous communities for courses which address the effects of trauma and which facilitate skills for healing. Admission is usually based on secondary or tertiary results however a range of alternative pathways are available. The language of instruction is English.
